COMMERCIAL DRIVERS LICENSE (CDL)

CDL 100 CDL Permit (4 credits)

This course is designed to assist students with the skills necessary to pass the North Dakota or South Dakota State Commercial Driver's License permit test.

CDL 105 NoviceCDL Training (5 credits)

This course is designed to provide students with a working knowledge of a tractor and trailer and preparation for the road CDL tests. Included in this course is, pre-trip inspection, basic driver skill training, and backing a tractor trailer combination. Students will take the CDL driving test to demonstrate their driving knowledge and skills. Lab component: students will be required to complete 28-hours of behind-the-wheel truck driving. Students must obtain their CDL Permit in order to participate in the driving portion of the class.

CDL 106 CDL Refresher Course (1 credit)

This course is designed to give students a review of the skills necessary to pass the North Dakota/South Dakota State Commercial Driver's License permit test.

CDL 107 Advanced CDL Driving (3 credits)

This course prepares students for advanced driving skills needed to obtain their commercial driver's license. Students must possess a current CDL permit in order to attend this class.

CDL 109 Driver Endorsements (3 credits)

This course covers an overview of the hazardous materials endorsement as well as additional driver endorsements.
